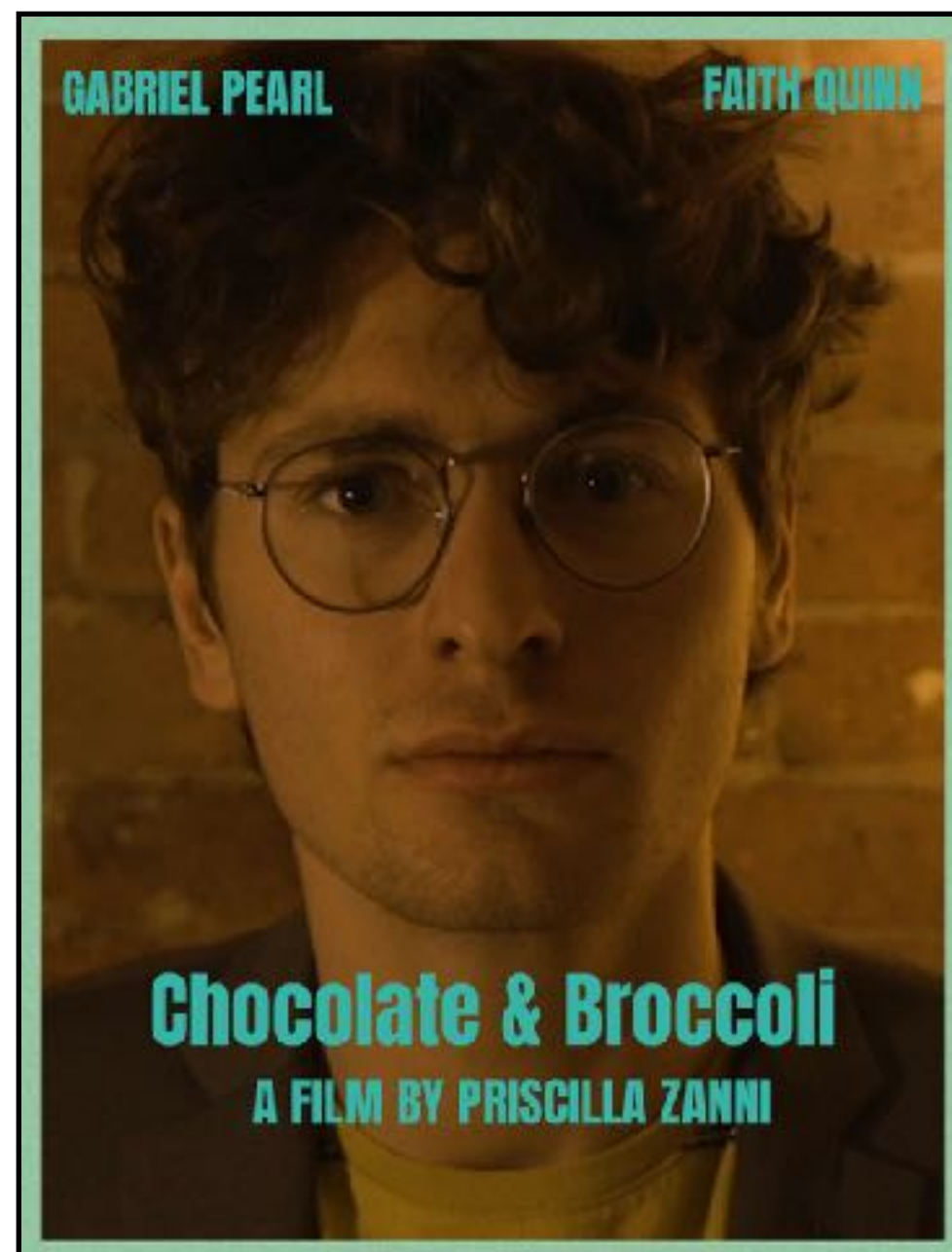
Logline: An obsessive stage mother has a neurotic crisis when she sees her twin daughters doing the wrong dance move in social media which causes a worldwide blackout.
